## The Lampstand - Lesson 4

- 1. What material was the candlestick made from? Exodus 25:31,39
- 2. How many branches shall come out from it? Exodus 25:32
- 3. What kind of designed did it have? Exodus 25:33-36
- 4. How did they mold and shape it into form? Exodus 37:22
  - a. How do trials help us? 1 Peter 1:7, James 1:2-4, Job 23:10, Romans 5:1-3
- 5. Was this a wax candle or what was used to make it light up? Exodus 35:14
  - a. What does oil symbolize? Zechariah 4:3-6
  - b. From the anointed ones that stand in God's presence divine light, love, and power are imparted to His people, that they may impart to others light and joy and refreshing. Those who are enriched are to enrich others with God's love. 6T 12
- 6. What did the Christ tell John about what the seven lamps represented? Revelation 1:20
- 7. What lesson did Christ give the disciples? Matthew 5:14-16
